Q: How often do I need to replace my breast implants?

A: It is a common misconception that breast implants need to be replaced every 10 years. There are a few reasons to replace your breast implants:

- ~ Increase the size of the implants.
- ~ Exchange to Silicone Gel implants.
- ~ Implant failure (deflation).
- ~ Capsular contracture (hardening of the breast).

Our practice has recently seen many patients who wish to exchange their saline implants for Silicone Gel implants. They more closely resemble breast tissue and are especially beneficial for those individuals with low body weight.
